### 9.35-11.30 Understanding the GDPR, with Q&A

This session provides participants with an introduction to data protection law, its key concepts, core principles, and their "real-world" implications. It also outlines the key features of the GDPR and provides participants with the "working knowledge" of data protection needed for the sessions that follow. Participants will have the opportunity to ask questions about any element of data protection that they do not understand.

#### 12.00-13.00 **Research activities under the GDPR**

This session explains the impact of the GDPR on different kinds of research activities. Participants will learn about the legal obligations on researchers and the practical implications for their research projects.

#### 13.00-14.30 Research ethics and data protection: EU rules and requirements

This session explains the intersection between the GDPR and the EC Êthics Guidelines, with which all EU-funded research must comply. Participants will learn how to ensure that their projects comply with all relevant EU rules and requirements on the processing of personal data, including the forthcoming EU "data ethics" guidance.

## 15.15-17.00 Group work and case studies

This session will entail group work where participants will be provided with "case studies", enabling them to put what they have learned into practice. This exercise will entail the groups assessing the data protection and ethics challenges arising from actual research proposals and devising action plans to ensure that the research meets legal and ethical requirements.
