

CIRCULAR CITIES CALL

The selected consortia will get direct funding of up to €20.000 and integrate a highly intensive and innovative 12 weeks-long innovation support programme, divided in two phases, to develop their business plan and adapt their solution for the targeted area (phase 1); and demonstrate their solutions in relevant environment and shape their commercial strategy (phase 2).

At the end of the accelerator programme, **5 consortia** will be selected to receive further funding of **€100.000**. They will have up to 6 months to develop their prototype and make test in operational environment in view of a commercial launch.

What's in it for SMEs?

- Up to €60k equity free funding per SME/Start-up
- One-to-one business coaching and mentoring support provided by industry experts

What are the minimum requirements to apply?

- Being a consortium of at least 2 SMEs/start-ups. One member must be an expert in circular economy and the other should provide digital/ICT technologies.
- Being based in one of the EU Member States or an H2020 Associated country. It is not mandatory to have a transnational consortium, but it will be positively evaluated (bonus in the evaluation).
- It is mandatory to address BOTH one of the circular cities topics/challenges + one of the sectors (see below)

Topics/challenges:

- 1. Autonomous Cities
- 2. Waste Management
- 3. Sustainable Consumption
- 4. Education

Circular City key sectors:

- 1. Buildings & Construction
- 2. Plastics
- 3. Food
- 4. Energy
- 5. Water
